BHM 310. The Art and Science of Health and Healing. (3 h)

BHM 385. Special Topics in Bioethics, Humanities, and Medicine. (1-3 h)

Offered by members of the faculty on specialized topics of their choice.

Reading, research, or internship courses designed to meet the needs and interests of students, to be carried out under the supervision of a faculty member. May be repeated for credit. P-POI.
