Requirements

Prior to declaring the minor, students must have minimum grade C or AP credit in ECN 150. Consists of 18 hours, including:

ECN 150	Introduction to Economics	3
ECN 205 or ECN 210	Intermediate Microeconomics I * Intermediate Mathematical Microeconomics	3
ECN 207 or ECN 211	Intermediate Macroeconomics * Intermediate Mathematical Macroeconomics	3

* Only one of ECN 205 or ECN 210, and one of ECN 207 or ECN 211 can be counted towards the minor.

The mathematics and minimum grade requirements for the minor are the same as for the major.
