

STATE AUTHORIZATION RECIPROCITY AGREEMENTS (SARA)

For the purposes of authorization in states outside of North Carolina, Wake Forest University participates in the State Authorization Reciprocity Agreements (SARA). In accordance with its participation in SARA, its other policies, and its mission and purpose, the University endeavours to resolve any student complaints at the institutional level. In some instances, however, students may also have the ability to make a complaint to the National Council for State Authorization Reciprocity Agreements (NC-SARA).
